Notice was received from Goodhue County that the Meyer Road Way seal coating had been completed and the turn-back maintenance period begins July 13, 2018. Goodhue County will reimburse Hay Creek Township for maintenance until July 14, 2010.

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**Discussion and Updates:**

Simanski Metals CUP update: The Goodhue County board has denied the Simanski Metals CUP.

Town Hall Entrance: Sue shared that she has spoken with a couple of companies about options for replacement of the front entrance ramp and railings. She will work on bringing back more firm recommendations to the September meeting.

Township Hall Lawn Maintenance: Concerns have been raised about the lack of lawn maintenance at the township hall. After discussion on options to have a formal lawn maintenance agreement, it was decided to have Ekblad's add lawn mowing and trimming to their township contract for the rest of the season and review and revisit options before next summer.

**Planning Commission:**

The next meeting will be held on September 19, 2018. The membership is looking for ideas to research, including the development of a growth map plan for the Highway 58 corridor from the City of Red Wing to Hwy 5 corner. A suggestion was for the planning commission to establish a subcommittee of citizens willing to research and pursue options for internet service for township residents.

**Road Report:**

- Valley View Road culver is in and seeding will be put in soon.
- Lehrbach Road culver is in. It needs more shoulder work and some grading soon.
- Tree trimming will begin soon on Orchard Road
- Road shoulder work will be done by Dressen's Saloon, and in South Oaks.
- Concerns about round bale storage in the right of way of Stumpf Lane and Langhans Road. Sue will call the landowner.
