Business:

Site Review – Variance Request: Travis and Becky Prihara were in attendance to discuss their request for a variance on road right of way and property line to add an addition to their home on Camp Lane. The supervisors had visited the property on the road review on April 22nd.

Road and Property Report:

- The excess old furniture was taken to Graves Auction and only the swing set and folding chairs were accepted. The supervisors will set the other furniture on the town hall lawn with a free sign and anything still there after a week will be disposed of.
- The road review findings were discussed. Priorities for 2021 will include:
 - Two culverts on Old Church Road
 - Tree trimming on Kohlshorn
 - Culverts on any roads not being rocked this year
 - Town hall railing is showing rust again. Sue will call the contractor.
 - Tires and trash on Wiebush Road will be cleaned to try to eliminate the dumping that has been happening in the ravine.
 - Lehrbach Road – Look at options for shaving into the hillside to straighten out the road. Discussed contacting the county for guidance as this could turn out to be a big project and we may need to go through a bid process.
